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Details of Library Collection

IT Central Library has a rich collection of 10546 books comprised of **3679 Text & 6867 Reference** cadre are the products of the renowned publishers such as **Cisco Press, Elsevier, Springer, Addison Wesley, Blackwell, John Wiley, CRC Press, McGrawhill International, Morgan Kaufmann, Palgrave McMillan, Routledge, River Press, Tata McGraw Hill, Prentice Hall of India, Pearson Education, Cengage Learning, Oxford University Press, Cambridge University Press, Dreamtech Press, Khanna Publishing etc.**; the core reference collection includes Encyclopaedias, General Dictionaries, Subject Dictionaries, Year Books, subject reference books and some rare books.

Central Library holds the collection on **‘General Reading Books’** covering the areas of **Fiction/Non-Fiction, Self Help, Motivation, Leadership, Interview Techniques, Soft Skills, General Management, Competitive examinations such as GATE, CAT, MPSC, UPSC and Books required for placement** related activities.

It is a regular practice of the Central Library to **scan the cover/content pages of newly arrived Books, Journals/Technical Magazines** domain wise and send the alert mail to all the students as well as faculty groups; **additionally library also host them on the library portal** for future reference and access. Collection Development Policy

Central Library has drafted its own 'Collection Development Policy'; it assures the procurement of information resources required by its stakeholders as per the domain. To attain overall collection development across all the domains, the requirements from the faculty members were asked by sharing the 'Google Sheet' from the library before the semester starts and asked them to put the details of the required book/s or any other information resources, this speeds up the process of selection and the required resource/s can be procured on time; on the other hand students also put their requirements by filling up the 'Book Requisition Form' kept in the library and need to drop it in the 'Drop Box' provided in the library; all the purchases are channelized through the 'Library Advisory Committee' by taking its approval & sanction from the concerned authorities.



Central Library Collection Development Policy

Collection development of learning resources constitutes one of the primary responsibility of the library and with the active support and advice of the 'Library Advisory Committee' it makes systematic efforts in building up the quality collection by identifying, evaluating, selecting, processing and disseminating it to the end users.

Whether it is a book (print or electronic), journal (print or electronic), audio-visual material or any learning resource that is to be procured goes through a rigorous selection process. Since the collection building process requires huge amount of money and has long-lasting repercussions; it is imperative that I2IT central library has a well thought out collection development policy in place.

- Collection development of library resources at I2IT is basically a patron driven activity or to be more precise, a faculty driven process; else students, staff members and the even the library also recommend books and other knowledge resources as per the need arises.
- Ideally, the allotted budget for procurement of books, journals and databases is assured an equitable distribution among all the domain specific academic areas of the institute.
- Users can make new suggestions/recommendations to the library through the Suggestion/Recommendation link available on the library portal; even patrons can also drop

their suggestions/recommendations by filling up the suggestion slip in to the suggestion box available in the library.

- Requested or recommended resources by the patrons are validated with the current collection to avoid the duplication of resource/s, cost and time; then it is kept before the 'Library Advisory Committee' followed by the approval from the Principal. The library takes diligent measures for timely supply of the ordered resources.
- Overall collection of the library is been and will be developed with the due consideration of the institutes' as well as library's vision, mission and objectives.



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
