The remote access has been provided to the patrons for accessing e-resources from outside the campus; for accessing **IEEE All Society Periodicals Package** users have to register their device/s (Laptop/Mobile/Tablet/Desktop) by using the institute's IP. on the e-resources portal in the institute's premises; post registration of the device the user need to personally sign up on the portal and then the remote access has been made available by the service provider. The users can access e-resources from anywhere either through their handheld or desktop devices.

In case of accessing J-Gate Engineering & Technology remotely, user need to register to My Favorite option, and post registration the user is allowed to access J-Gate journals and their favorite Journals outside the IP range.
